

Car Pool Daily Prayer

As a father (or mother) I begin our prayer time, bringing us all under the Kingdom of God. Declaring the Kingdom of God over their school, leadership, teachers. And with that, wherever God leads.

Then we pray together (someone leading and everyone else repeating):

God we agree with who you are. (Ex 3:14, John 14:6)

We agree with what you are doing. (Phil 1:6)

We agree with how you are doing it. (Isaiah 55:9)

We declare that you love us as much as you love your son Jesus (John 17:23), therefore we have nothing to fear. (Rom 8:15)

We ask for a revelation of your affection. (Eph 1:17)

We ask that you would make the impossible possible today. (Luke 1:37, MT 17:20)

We put on the armor of God (Eph 6:11):

-Shoes of the Gospel.

-Belt of Truth.

-Breastplate of righteousness.

-Helmet of salvation.

-Sword of the Spirit.

-And Shield of faith.

-We choose to wield these weapons at all times and we choose to pray in the Spirit.

We accept your acceptance of us. (Rom 15:7, Heb 12:6)

We choose to live in the present moment (MT 6:27).

We ask for a wise and discerning heart. (James 1:5)

We unite our hearts with your heart. (John 17:21-23)

We choose to listen to your voice. (John 10:4)

We ask you to Father us today. (Psalm 68:5, 2 Cor 6:18)

(We can then pause and ask the Father to speak to us any words of counsel or love or instruction to lead us through the day.)
